What is The S.C.A?

The Society for Conservation in Aviculture (S.C.A) was formed in 1993, when a need became apparent to start to conserve avian species before they were lost forever. The Society aims to promote and develop all species and varieties of birds kept by aviculturists, with special regard to threatened and endangered species both in the wild and in captivity.

With ever increasing demands being placed on the earth, some species of birds are becoming increasingly at risk. Action must be taken now to ensure that aviculture plays its part in the conservation of such species. Everyone can help in some way.

The society strongly discourages deliberate acts of hybridization to supply the pet trade with exotic cross breeds. It is very much opposed to the commercial trapping & importing of wild caught birds.

Our prime concern at all times is for the future survival and welfare of all birds. The officers of the society play an active role in promoting responsible care and ownership of all birds.

Anyone who has a concern for the wellbeing and future conservation of all birds should join. You do not need to be a bird keeper yourself to join. Likewise, pet bird owners, breeders or the serious aviculturalists are all welcome to join.

S.C.A helpline

The society has many experienced members interested in all types of birds. Advice about care, breeding, behavioral problems, conservation & stray birds etc is available to all members. The S.C.A has contacts with governing bodies, specialist societies and is a society recognised by the R.S.P.C.A as a specialist in its field.

The S.C.A holding station & sanctuary

The society is very proud to have been able to build a holding station and sanctuary with help from its supporters. Here, birds which require rehoming or sanctuary for a variety of reasons, can be cared for.

Members of the society who have suitable and proper accommodation could be potential foster carers for a suitable bird. An appropriate administration fee is required when birds are placed and membership of the society must be maintained by standing order otherwise the bird must be returned to the S.C.A immediately.

All birds remain the property of the society at all times, and must not be sold or passed on to any third party.
